QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q. What makes Nye Legacy Health and Rehabilitation unique?

A. Nye Legacy is designed on a neighborhood concept that provides specialized care to meet your needs. Our state of the art rehabilitation campus provides inpatient and out patient therapy services that include a spacious wellness center and therapy pool area.

Q. Can Nye Legacy Health and Rehabilitation meet my needs?

A. Nye Legacy Health and Rehabilitation is unique to the Fremont community. We have a continuum of services from Medicare-certified, long-term health care to independent retirement housing as part of the Nye Senior Services system of services. This allows us to best serve the individual needs of each resident. This ability as well as our family atmosphere sets us apart from other health and rehabilitation facilities in the area.

Q. Does Medicare, Medicaid or insurance cover care at Nye Legacy?

A. Medicare may cover the cost of some short term nursing home stays provided you meet the requirements, which includes a three night stay in the hospital and the need for a daily skilled service. Medicaid will pay for long term care for a resident who meets the financial and care criteria. Long-term care insurance policies may also provide coverage depending on your level of care and insurance policy criteria. Our staff is here to help you evaluate your options. Please let us know if we can help you.

Q. May I bring some of my own furnishings?

A. You are encouraged to personalize your room with some of your own furnishings. Nye Legacy will provide essential furniture including a bed, night stand and a chair.

Q. What happened if I no longer need skilled care?

A. Nye Legacy has an interdisciplinary discharge team that can assist you in creating a successful discharge plan to best meet your needs and level of care. Nye Senior Services also has an independent retirement campus and assisted living services.

Q. Am I responsible for household insurance?

A. Nye Legacy provides insurance for the building structure and common areas, but does not cover your personal property. We recommend Renter's Insurance for your personal belongings.

Q. Can I have overnight guests?

A. Absolutely. A guest suite is available by reservation for guests of residents within the Nye Senior Services system at both Nye Legacy and Nye Square Retirement Community.
